This Workshop is open to everyone from beginners to advanced operators. It will be an invaluable experience for all. Each participant will be given the chance to acquire profound practical and theoretical experience in coping with both the technical and creative demands of a production. During these five days you will be exposed to a wide range of techniques and practices from the basics of setting up the equipment, development of physical skills and operating techniques, as well as the design and creation of shots.

Each day will start at 7 am with a specifically adapted Yoga/Pilates lesson (optional) followed by breakfast. From then on (9am) there will be lectures and demonstrations, followed by personal instruction on a rotating basis with each of the instructors in small groups.

At the end of each day we will have dinner together and you will then be free to discuss the results of the day or resume practice with the Steadicam™ or discuss technical things with invited specialists.

Each participant will have extensive opportunities to practice and train with the Steadicam™ and all the other equipment we will have at the workshop.

We will watch and discuss classic Steadicam™ shots, especially those of the instructors™ who can add commentary and answer questions about them.

On the last day each group will conceive and shoot a short movie, one of which will receive an award during the "wrap party". Every participant will receive a Certificate for the workshop.

The workshop will be held in German, English, French, and upon request, in Italian.
